



Professional Development for Leaders

This element of the T Level Professional Development (TPD) offer will provide you with a good understanding of T Levels, so you can shape the direction of your organisation, support the wider leadership team and monitor progress and outcomes.

Course: Operational Middle Leaders and Managers: Leadership and Professional Practice for T Level Planning and Implementation

Who is it useful for?

- Operational middle leaders and managers whose role includes curriculum development, management and planning and those working with roles associated with employer engagement, industry placements or similar.

Course outline:

This course supports the development of operational middle leaders and managers, as they lead their teams and support their organisational readiness for successful T Level delivery. The course focusses on leadership theory and professional practice.

The course has two face-to-face* workshops:

- Leading curriculum change for T Levels
- Working collaboratively: effective leadership practice to plan, implement and deliver.

Study mode:

It is possible to study the content of this course both online and face-to-face*. The two course options are similar but not identical and there is considerable benefit to attending both courses.

We recommend you complete the online course first to be better prepared for the face-to-face events.

Although this is not mandatory, it will maximise the impact of your CPD activity.

- Online course (TLPD12): Operational Middle Leaders and Managers: Leadership and Professional Practice for T Level Planning and Implementation
Recommended six hours of self-guided learning.
- Face-to-face event (C0931): Operational Middle Leaders and Managers
Each workshop will last three hours. There is the option for two workshops to be facilitated flexibly within a day's training.
- In-house training can be facilitated for your team as a group, either face-to-face or virtually. Please contact your [Regional Facilitator](#) for more information.

Learning outcomes:

Participants will have the knowledge and confidence to:

- use a range of 'thinking tools'
- identify the key principles for managing a T Level 'change' project
- extend their understanding of what it means to work 'collaboratively'
- identify and practice strategies for developing shared understanding and vocabulary when working with others.

Entry requirements:

There are no specific entry requirements for this course, however it is expected that you would be leading or managing the planning and implementation of T Levels within your Further Education provider. The TLPD offer is provided at no charge to ESFA funded providers. Face-to-face events are aimed at those delivering T Levels in 2020 and 2021.
