



## Professional Development for Leaders

This element of the T Level Professional Development (TLPD) offer will provide you with a good understanding of T Levels, so you can shape the direction of your organisation, support the wider leadership team and monitor progress and outcomes.

### Course: Strategic Leaders Providing T Levels

#### Who is it useful for?

- CEOs, principals, headteachers, deputy principals, vice principals, executive directors, directors, heads of department and those with strategic responsibility within their organisation.

#### Course outline:

This course is designed to enable senior leaders to understand the impact T Levels will have within their organisation and their wider community. It includes considerations of effective employer partnership, organisational change, and how T Levels are positioned within the curriculum offer and resourced effectively.

#### Study mode:

It is possible to study the content of this course both online and face-to-face\*. The two course options are similar but not identical and there is considerable benefit to attending both courses.

We recommend you complete the online course first to be better prepared for the face-to-face event. Although this is not mandatory, it will maximise the impact of your CPD activity.

Recommended six hours of self-guided learning.
- Face-to-face\* event (CO930): Strategic Leaders Providing T Levels  
Three sessions, each lasting two hours.

Participants will have the knowledge and confidence to:

- discuss the key principles of curriculum design for T Levels
- reflect on the core components of T Levels: industry placements, employer-led projects, embedding digital and the systems and processes required
- share approaches to work with stakeholders
- use Teach Too principles, approaches and toolkits to frame their co-design planning and delivery.

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### Entry requirements:

There are no specific entry requirements for this course, however it is expected you would be leading the planning and implementation of T Levels within your Further Education provider. The TLPD offer is provided at no charge to ESFA funded providers. Face-to-face events are aimed at those delivering T Levels in 2020 and 2021.
